RULE 4 DEFINITION OF "FINANCIAL YEAR" IF AMENDED "Financial Year" means the period that commences on 1 June 2019 and concludes on 31 March 2020. Note: This period of 10 months is a special transition period for the 2019 to 2020 financial year. "Financial Year" means the period that commences on 1 April of any year and concludes on 31 March the following year. Note: This definition applies after 31 March 2020.

Board: 2019-20 season no change to registrations has been accounted for, not sustainable at 15,500 registrations.

Williamstown: do we have any research around why kids are leaving little athletics? Sherrie Boulter responded: surveys have been done, feedback too long waiting time, too much volunteering, recommend centres survey non returning members to see if there are other reasons why not returning. Gemba research has been completed, not abnormally high in churn against other sports. Issues seen at 6-10 age group, 12 upwards slowing increasing year on year.
