SUBJECT: COVID-19 lockdown across Victoria

Effective from 11.59pm last night (Thursday) the Victorian State Government has placed all of Victoria under lockdown until 11.59pm Tuesday 20th July.

Accordingly, community sports, inclusive of sanctioned Little Athletics activities (training and competition), are not permitted (officially 'closed') for this period. This applies to all LAVic members and Centres residing and based in Victoria.

The lockdown restrictions, which state that residents stay at home (unless for one of six exempted reasons), precludes Victorian border bubble residents from participating in Little Athletics in NSW.

For members residing in NSW, and Centres located in NSW affiliated with LAVic, Little Athletics activities may still be conducted in accordance with the [NSW restrictions](#).
