SUBJECT: Come & Try Days; restrictions update

- Come & Try Days are not currently permitted
- Restriction changes for Shepparton and Ballarat

Come & Try Days

Advising that under the current restrictions, Come & Try Days are not permitted.

By their nature, Come & Try Days are held for the purpose of attracting prospective (unregistered or previously registered) athletes, in a modified competition format. Modified competition in any guise, recorded or not recorded, is not currently permitted.

At present, only sanctioned training can be conducted by regional Victoria-based Centres for registered athletes (inclusive of those registered as Trial Athletes).

Restrictions update

As of earlier today it was announced that:

- The City of Ballarat, will be placed in lockdown from 11.59pm tonight until 11.59pm on Wednesday 22nd September. The same restrictions now apply as in metro Melbourne. From a Little Athletics perspective, all sanctioned training and coaching is not permitted during this period.
- The City of Greater Shepparton's restrictions will revert back to align with regional Victorian restrictions from midnight tonight.
