SUBJECT: Flood grants, Membership, Multi-Class resources

Flood grants update

The Victorian State Government has announced the following grant assistance programs for flood affected sporting clubs. LAVic affiliated Centres impacted by floods are encouraged to apply. See the details and links below:

- <u>Community Sport Emergency Flood Assistance Program</u>: closing 13th January 2023. One-off grants up to \$5000, paid within 10 days of approval.
- <u>Business and Community Sport Flood Recovery Grants:</u> closing 1st May 2023. Tier 1: up to \$25,000; Tier 2: subsequent grant payments up to \$50,000 (inclusive of the \$5,000 from the Community Sport Emergency Flood Assistance Program).

Eligible Centres must be located within a <u>local government area</u> declared under the <u>Disaster</u> Recovery Funding Arrangement ('defined disaster area').

Membership

As of today, the combined athlete membership across all LAVic affiliated Centres stands at 15,560 (compared with 15,503 in total for 21/22).

Of our newly established Centres, Port Fairy has 116 registered athletes, Nagambie held its first competition day on 5th November, Hamilton is set to commence competition after Christmas.

Sadly, Rochester has advised that it be entering recess for the rest of 22/23 following the devasting floods in that town due to the enormous and direct impact on member families' lives, massive damage done to Windridge Oval and the loss of equipment.

Seymour also has been badly affected by flooding and has suffered damage to its track and equipment. It's committee is in the process of assessing its options for the remainder of 22/23.

Given the weather/flood related challenges faced by every single Centre, and coming off two severely curtailed seasons, our Centre's combined membership effort this season has been nothing short of amazing.
