SUBJECT: **Updated COVID-19 restrictions - Victorian Centres**

The Victorian Government has announced that most COVID-19 restrictions will be removed from 11:59pm, Friday 22 April 2022. As far as able to be determined, changes affecting Little Athletics activities at Victorian Centres will include:

Check ins:

- There is no longer the requirement to register attendance (check-in via the Service Victoria app) at Little Athletics training and competition activities.
- There is no further requirement to maintain attendance records.

Centre contacts:

- Individuals will still be required to notify their Centre in the event of testing positive, and if they've attended a Little Athletics activity in the days prior.
- Centres will not have to notify their members, or LAVic, of positive cases.
- Little Athletics attendees that are close contacts – and are no longer required to quarantine - will be allowed to train, compete, coach, officiate, volunteer, spectate etc provided they wear face mask indoors, avoid sensitive settings, and undertake at least five negative rapid antigen tests over the seven days that would previously have been the self-quarantine period.

Non-competition activities

- People attending the Centre in person for reasons other than training or competition (such as committee meetings, working bees, social events, fundraising activities, presentation days etc) that are 18 years and over, are no longer required to show their vaccination status.

The LAVic COVID-19 protocols will be updated in coming days following the release of the next State Government Pandemic Order document and update to the www.coronavirus.vic.gov.au website.
