60 Years Region Challenge

On the 20 October 2024, Little Athletics Victoria will be hosting a special 'Region Challenge', bringing together a selected group of U10-U17 athletes to compete in a team's competition format.

The challenge will be held in conjunction with the LAVic 60 Years Open Day, available to all 2024/25 U09-U17 registered athletes and promises to be a fun, exciting day of competition and participation.

In the Region Challenge, athletes will be awarded points for each of their performances and will go towards their Region's aggregate points total. The teams with the three highest overall points, after pre allocated points have been applied will be presented with gold, silver or bronze medals (including team managers). Commemorative medals will be presented to the other four Region teams and certificates provided to all competing athletes. Appointed officials will also receive a commemorative medal.

Eligibility

For an athlete to be eligible for selection by their Region for the 60 Years Region Challenge, athletes must:

- 1. Be registered & financial for the 2024/25 Season prior to the closing date for Region Team submission.
- 2. Have competed in their Region's 2023/24 Region Track & Field Carnival.

Please note athletes cannot compete in both the 60 Years Region Challenge and Open Day events.

Team Selection

Region Selection Committees are required to select a team of 38 athletes based on the following criteria:

- 1. Each team will consist of athletes from the U10 to U17 age groups of the 2024/25
- 2. Each Region Selection Committee will select a team of eligible athletes up to a maximum of 38 athletes derived from the first three placegetters of the U09 to U16 able bodied age groups and a maximum of 4 Multiclass (MC) athletes of the 2023/24 Region Track & Field Carnival of their Region.
- 3. Each team will consist of a maximum of 19 boys and 19 girls with a **maximum** of
 - 2 x male & 2 x female athletes from each able-bodied age group (U09-U16)
 - 3 x male & 3 x female wildcard athletes from any age group (U09 U16)
 - 2 x male & 2 x female Multiclass athletes from any age group (U09 U16).

of the 2023/24 season.

4. Except for wildcard athletes, athletes will only compete in events in their own age group. Wildcard athletes may compete in their own age group or one age group up except for hurdles events where athletes can only compete in their own age group. Athletes <u>cannot be selected</u> from the <u>2024/25 U09 age group</u>.

- **5.** Each athlete can only compete in a <u>maximum of three individual events plus one</u> relay.
- 6. Where a Region cannot select a team from the first three placegetters from the 2024 Region Track & Field Carnival of their Region due to athletes not being available or not registered Regions can select from a subsequent list of the top eight placegetters from the 2024 Region Track and Field Carnival of their Region.

Please feel free to contact LAVic if your Region is having difficulty selecting a team.

Team Entries

Regions will be required to enter their final team on-line via the LAVic website.

Entries open: 9:00am Monday 7th October 2024

Entries close 5:00pm Friday 11th October 2024.

For an athlete to be eligible to represent their Region, they must have registered as a LAVic member for the 2024/25 season prior to the team being entered.

LATE entries will not be accepted.

Payment

There is no charge for the athletes to participate in the **Region Challenge**.

Team Manager Nomination

Each Region will be required to nominate two Team Managers for the competition.

Team Manager details will need to be submitted at the same time as the teams are entered.

All Team Manager nominations must be completed by 5:00pm Friday 11th October 2024.

Please notify LAVic if the Team Manager details change prior to the Region Challenge.

Events Conducted

There will be six events for each age group and gender. Additionally, there will be Mixed Age & Gender 4 x 100m Relays and a Mixed Age 1200m Medley Relay.

Mixed Age & Sex 4x100m Relay – Team must consist of 2 boys & 2 girls. For the U10-11 & U12-13 age groups there must be 2 athletes from each age group. For the U14-17 there must be a minimum of 1 athlete from each age group.

Mixed Age 1200m Medley - Team must consist of one athlete from each age group.

Note: Wildcard athletes can be used as the athlete one age group up.

Event Timetable

Please refer to attached Region Challenge timetable.

Uniforms

Region singlets in various sizes will be distributed to teams in the lead-up to the event. The singlets will need to be returned at the conclusion of the day's competition.

All athletes competing must wear their Region uniform.

Athletes not in correct uniforms may result in the athlete not being allowed to compete.

Athletes must wear black, navy or their centre colour shorts or leggings

The Rules covering uniforms are detailed in Rule 143 as found in the LAVic Competition Rules.

Footwear

The rules covering Footwear and Shoes, including the use of spikes, is **Rule 143** as found in the LAVic Competition Rules.

Athletes are NOT permitted to wear spikes in the Mixed Age Medley relay.

Call Room

Accredited Region Team Managers are only permitted in the Call Room whilst assisting their own athletes.

Coaches, age group managers, parents, friends or spectators will not be permitted to enter or remain within the Call Room.

It is each Region's responsibility to ensure that their athletes are in correct uniform and are at the Call Room by the required time before the scheduled start time of the event.

Region Challenge Points

The Region Challenge is a team event with each athlete scoring points towards their Region's total, based on their placing in each event. Each Region has been pre allocated points based on each Regions performances at the 2023/24 Region Track & Field carnivals. Please refer to the '60 Years Region Challenge & Open Day Technical Regulations' for further information regarding the allocation of adjusted points.

Please note the following:

- 1. Points will be allocated to each athlete who successfully completes an event.
- 2. No points will be allocated to athletes who have been disqualified in an event.
- 3. Points will be allocated per event as follows:

1st place – 7 points	5th place – 3 points		
2nd place – 6 points	6th place – 2 points		
3rd place – 5 points	7th place – 1 point		
4th place – 4 points			

- **4.** For Relay events, points will be doubled for each place as per RC & OD Technical Regulation 41.
- 5. The team with the highest number of points when the pre allocated points and the points accumulated throughout the competition will be declared the winner.

Region Challenge Awards

Award medals will be presented to all athletes & team managers of the first three placed winning teams, and a trophy presented to the winning Region Team.

A commemorative medal will be presented to the other four region teams competing athletes and team managers. In addition, officials will be given a commemorative gift.

Technical Regulations

Please refer to the '60 Years Region Challenge & Open Day (RC & OD) Technical Regulations' for further regulations pertaining to these competitions.

Team managers will be required to submit High Jump start heights and Triple Jump take off boards for athletes contesting these events. Forms will be made available to team managers prior to the Region Challenge.

Relays

Athletes are only permitted to compete in **one** relay.

- For the 4x100mMixed Age & Sex Relay the team will consist of 2 boys and 2 girls. The U11/12 & U12/13 age groups must comprise of 2 athletes from each age group. For the U14-16 there must be a minimum of 1 athlete from each age.
- Fort he Mixed Age Medley each team must consist of one athlete from each age group. A wildcard athlete can be used as the athlete one age group up.

Team managers are required to submit Relay Teams Sheets at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the first relay event. Forms will be made available to team managers prior to the event.

Venue Entry

There will be no admittance fees to the venue.

Event Release Form

An Event Release Form will only be required if there is a clash of events created by an on the day athlete substitution or change of event time which has not been previously determined from the LAVic supplied clash report.

These forms will be made available to Team Managers prior to the event and will also be available upon request in the Communications Room.

Substitute Athletes

After the closing date for entries, an athlete may be substituted in the Region Team up until two (2) days prior to the day of competition.

Notification must be received by the LAVic Office, within the timeframe advised.

From two (2) days prior to the first day of competition, an athlete can only be substituted in an event by an athlete already named in the team.

Athletes that have been substituted into an event, can only compete up to the maximum number of events allowed for an athlete and unless the athlete is a wildcard athlete cannot compete in a promoted age group

A Substitute Athlete Form will only be required if an athlete is to be substituted in an event on the day of competition.

These forms will be made available to Team Managers prior to the event and will also be available upon request in the Administration Room.
